Volunteers who are in roles with children or vulnerable adults are required to complete safeguarding training **every three years.**

All volunteers working with children or adults at risk must **complete Level 3**. The course autosaves as the learner progresses, so it can be returned to at the convenience of the learner.

**Certificates for completed course are available to download and print** – these are not required for the Diocesan Safeguarding Office as separate notification is sent to the office with details of volunteer's enrolment and completion of the course.
