Two Big Sinners

Saints Peter and Paul are twin pillars, the foundation of the Church. They are also two big sinners who, in different ways needed to be rescued.

Peter denied Jesus three times. Paul persecuted the early Christians, and oversaw the killing of St Stephen, the first martyr. Both knew what it was to mess up, be forgiven, be transformed and changed by grace.

They were unlikely and unworthy candidates on which to build the Church. But they were made worthy by the Lord.

What is true for them is also true for us. None of us can sit back and say I'm not good enough, I'm not holy enough. They weren't, and neither are we. That's not the point.

Only if we truly accept the power of grace, freely given – literally *gratis*, to change us, can we step up and rebuild and refashion the Church in our own age.
